Blood Pressure should be recorded for every patient presenting with any of the following conditions:

- Suspected Pregnancy
- Known Pregnancy
- Abdominal Pain
- Urinary Symptoms
- PV Bleed
- Vomit
- Diarrhoea
- Lumbar Pain
- Inguinal Pain
- High Temperature
- Chest Pain
- Dehydration
- History of Hypertension
- Any Cardiovascular Conditions
- Allergic Reaction
- Use of any Cardiotonic or Modulator Medication (*-lol, -pril -sartan -dipine, -azem, -pamil*)
- Any Visit for a Long-Term Repeat Prescription
- All Patients with Diabetes History
- All Patients with Pre-Diabetes
- All Patients with Kidney Disease
- All Patients with Liver Disease
- All Patients on Antiretroviral Therapy
- All Patients with Genetic Malformations / Syndromes
